Information about Dress Code and School Uniforms

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As a part of the Pythagoras Children's Academy Dress Code Policy, all students are required to wear white shirts with a collar or turtleneck, or a white or blue sweater. Boys may wear blue pants or shorts. Girls may wear blue pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers. On church days specified in the school calendar, girls must wear a jumper or skirt, and all students should wear dress shoes. Children may bring an extra pair of shoes to change after the church service, as only rubber-soled shoes should be worn when in the school gymnasium.

These clothing items are available through FrenchToast.com and at many local stores, such as Target, Kohls, Sears, Old Navy, The Children's Place, and more. When ordering items online at frenchtoast.com, enter the code **QS47EK6** and our school will receive 5% of all proceeds.

Once a month, the school has a "casual day" when students are not required to follow the dress code. Any clothing students wear at school should be free of pictures or commercial advertising.

Girls' and boys' hair should be combed neatly, away from the eyes and face.

Children wearing boots to school because of rain or snow should bring indoor shoes as well.

Also, please keep in mind that each student must provide a change of **uniform** to be kept at school and stored in your child's cubby, including undergarments and socks, to be used in the event of any unforeseen accident during activities. Extra uniforms should be placed in a Ziploc bag with your child's name printed on the bag. All clothing should also be marked with the child's name.

Children's names should be on all outerwear. Lost clothing and items that are unmarked will be placed in the "lost and found box" in the community center. Parents are encouraged to check the "lost and found box" periodically for missing items.
