Math

- Recognize and draw shapes

- Count from 1-100 by 1's, 5's, and 10's
- Sort by color, shape, and size
- Recognize a pattern and continues a pattern

Phonics

Use Michael Heggerty Phonemic Awareness program:

The daily lessons in all versions contain the same ten skills: letter naming, rhyming, onset fluency, blending, identifying final and/or medial sounds, segmenting, adding, deleting and substituting phonemes

Language Awareness

- Know all uppercase/lowercase letters
- Familiarity of all consonant/ both long/short vowel sounds
 - Begin to recognize sight words
 - Begin stringing sounds/letters together to read a word

Reading Comprehension

• Retell a story (identify main character(s), main idea, and plot.

Developmental Writing

- Draw a picture to relate a message
- Write a single word using sound/letter correspondence
- Write a single sentence.
- Write uppercase and lowercase letters properly
- Print letters of first/last name

e Experiments with various crafts such as crayons, paints, markers, play dough, stamps, glue, and scissors

Music

- Sings daily to enhance learning
- Uses instruments
- Performs school programs
- Sings the Greek National Anthem, the Hymn of the Day, and recites the Pledge of Allegiance

Social Studies and Science

A variety of thematic units are covered throughout the year. Some topics are Thanksgiving, seasons, Christmas, and other holidays.
